Alabaster Mobile Clinic is a non-profit, charitable healthcare organization based in California, which provides health services and health education to unreached, impoverished rural and urban communities internationally, primarily in Africa and South Asia. Alabaster consists of volunteer doctors, nurses, nurse practitioners, and other healthcare professionals whose mission is to serve those most in need. Alabaster enters a community, whether it is a slum or tribal dwelling, to meet primary health care needs, treating both acute and chronic illnesses, and disseminating health education.

2018 Accomplishments

February 2018: Begin planning Alabaster's program expansion to Turkana County. In partnership with GCN, community gatekeepers, health workers and liaisons are identified.

May 2018: Alabaster welcomes new board member and treasurer: Leela Braganza, CPA

July 2018: Alabaster 2018 team travels to Kenya. Alabaster enters into discussions with county government officials to ensure permanent health worker staffed at Endonyolasho Clinic by early 2019. Alabaster teams visits Turkana County – Lolupe and Kotela and begins discussions on partnerships in this new community. 3000 sanitary napkins distributed to schools throughout Kenya.

October 2018: Proposal and building plan finalized to begin construction of Endonyolasho Community Library. Begin discussions for community garden design in Lolupe School in Turkana.

November 2018: Launched Giving Tuesday fundraising campaign for Endonyolasho Community Library
